

Contest Guidelines

We have 6 windows and 2 walls in total to fill with art from all artists.

Theme

The contest will have a unifying theme that reflects the essence and identity of Lancaster promoting a sense of community and culture.

Participant Eligibility

All artists of any age residing within the city limits of the AV will be eligible to participate in the contest.

Artistic Medium

Artists will use Tempera /Acrylic non-permanent paints which are suitable for window surfaces, ensuring easy removal and preparation for future contests or updates.

Duration

The contest will span from Oct 25th to Nov 25th, allowing artists ample time to plan and execute their mural designs. The winning artist's work will be displayed from Jan 1st to Dec 31st 2024.

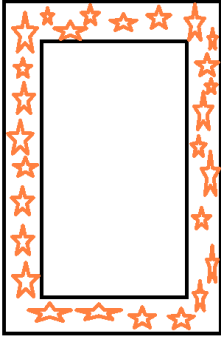
Judging Criteria

A panel of esteemed judges will evaluate the entries based on creativity, adherence to the theme, skill, and overall visual impact.

The winners of the contest will receive a gift card for **\$150**. City and Community recognition, and have their work displayed for a duration of 1 year, Jan 1st 2024 to Dec 31st 2024.

Display Types

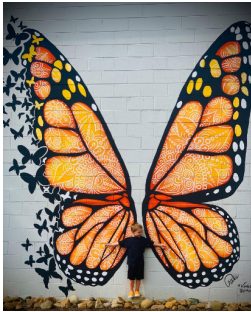
There are 3 different display types, and each artist is encouraged to apply for all 3 types allowing for more than 1 winning display.



Display Type 1

4 count 64x76 windows

The design concept for these 4 windows will be in the form of frames. Each frame will need to be no more than 12 inches in width creating a border.



Display Type 2

2 count 58x82 Windows

The design concept for these two windows will be in the form of wings. This image can take up the entire window space.



Display Type 3

1 count 7x12 wall

1 count 5x12 wall

The design concept for these two are poppy walls. We would like the artist's work to cover the entire space.

Note: The winners will be asked to incorporate their **names, social media handles, hashtag for the project (#artonthelvd), along with the social media handles for the City of Lancaster, The Blvd Association and Destination Lancaster.** This information will need to be placed at the bottom of their art work.
